

1. Front Panel View



ON / STBY buttom

Press to put the unit into standby mode or turn it on.

REPEAT buttom

Repeats the current track or all tracks in an album.

SRC buttom

Upconvert 44.1KHz to higher sample rate.

OPEN / CLOSE buttom

Open or close the disc tray.

STANDBY I FD

The LED lights up to indicate that the unit in standby mode.

STOP buttom

Stop playback.

PLAY buttom

Play disc or pause.


PREV buttom

Digital Outputs:


IIS / DSD: Use the HDMI cable to transmit IIS and DSD data to the DAC with sample rates up to PCM 384KHz and DSD 11.2MHz.

COAXIAL: Transmits PCM up to 384KHz and DOP 64 and DOP 128.

OPTICAL: Transmits PCM up to 192KHz and DOP 64.

AES/EBU: Transmits PCM up to 384KHz and DOP 64 and DOP 128.




Pin 1: Ground

6. AC Inlet: Connect the supplied mains lead to the AC IN (115V or 230 V) terminal on the rear panel.



Pin 1 : Live Conductor : L

Pin 2: Ground Conductor: PE

Pin 3: Neutral Conductor: N


AC Voltage Selector: Make sure that the AC voltage selector switch at the bottom of the unit is switched to the appropriate voltage for your country. All Lotus DAC5 SE are shipped with the switch set to 230V AC in order to prevent accidental damage.



7. Ground terminal: Chassis ground.



8. Remote Control



ON / STBY: Press to put the unit into standby mode or turn it on.

OPEN / CLOSE: Open or close the disc tray.

REPEAT: Repeats the current track or all tracks in an album.

SRC: Upconvert 44.1KHz to higher sample rate.

REW: Rewind, release the button to return to normal play mode.

FF: Fast-forward, release the button to return to normal play mode.

PREV: Jump to the beginning of the previous track.

NEXT: Jump to the next track and play.

STOP: Stop playback.

PLAY: Play disc or pause.

Battery Replacement:


To change the battery, please remove the 4 screws and the bottom cover to reveal the battery casing.

9. Start Up

Press the POWER key on the front panel or on the remote control to turn on CDT1, and the display will first show CDT1.

NOTE: All functions are disabled during disc reading until the disc is ready.

The full album information is displayed once the disc is successfully loaded.




- 1. Normal Playback Mode: Display current playback mode, Repeater off mode.
- 2. Total tracks of the album: Display how many tracks are content in the album, Up to 99 tracks can be displayed.
- 3. Total time of the album: Display the combine play time of all tracks in the album, Up to 74 minutes can be displayed.

If no disc is placed or incorrect format is being loaded, No DISC is displayed.




OPEN / CLOSE buttom

To place a CD, press the OPEN / CLOSE button on the front panel or on the remote control to eject the CD tray.




Place the CD on the tray after the tray is ejected, and then press the OPEN / CLOSE button again to close the tray.



After the tray is closed, the disc will be read and the status of the disc will be displayed.

PLAY buttom

After the disc reading is complete, press the PLAY button on the front panel or on the remote control to start playing.



Press the PLAY button again during playback to pause the playback. In the pause mode, the playback time pauses and flashes. to continue playing, press the PLAY button again.

STOP buttom

Pressing the STOP button on the front panel or on the remote control to stop playback

PREV & NEXT buttom

Short press the PREV or Next button in the playback state to skip to the previous or next track. If the playing time does not exceed 3 seconds of the current track, Press the PREV button to skip to the previous track. If the playback time exceeds the current track by more than 3 seconds, Press the PREV button to start playing from the 0th second of the current track. Short press the PREV or Next button in the stopped state to select the track you want to play, Press the PLAY button again to start playing the selected track.


REW & FF buttom

Press and hold REW or FF during playback to fast rewind backward or fast forward the current playing track, release to resume playback.


REPEAT buttom

Pressing the REPEAT button on the front panel or on the remote control to toggle between the playback modes, REPEAT ONE, REPEAT ALL and REPEAT OFF.

When REPEAT ONE is selected, only the current track will be played repeatedly, In REPEAT ONE mode, pressing the Previous / Next button will only repeat the current playback playing track, Does not skip to previous or next track.




When REPEAT ALL is selected, all tracks in the album will be played repeatedly in track order.



SRC buttom

SRC allows you to up-convert the sampe rate to your desired value, to set SRC press the SRC button on the front panel or on the remote control. Open the SRC menu, then use the PREV or NEXT button to switch the desired sample rate , the selected sample rate will be set immediately when switching, press the SRC button again to return to normal playback mode.

Please note that once SRC menu is active, other functions is disable until back to normal play mode.
